GOD IS LOOKING FOR YOUTHS WITHOUT BLEMISH.



WHAT TYPE OF YOUTHS DOES GOD REQUIRE OR NEED?

Daniel 1:3-4 "...children in whom there was no blemish". See the qualifications of the youths that the king required at that time for service in Babylon's administration. They were to undergo a course of training in administration, and they wanted to give them every opportunity to be properly groomed so that the king's business would not suffer.

Youths, there is something I want to tell you this afternoon. Try to place the first thing in its rightful position. For you youths in this gospel, your life is hinged on three important things. First, and at the top of the list, is the salvation of your soul. Have these definite Christian experiences and live by them. That should be the very first thing forming the foundation of your life. Secondly, pursue your academics to the fullest potential with which God has endowed you. Thirdly, actively engage in something within the gospel. Why? Because doing so will yield great dividends for you in the future.

One of the temptations that lurks near you is ambition—the desire to pursue money. If you give your life to pleasure, pleasure will take its toll on you. If you follow the pleasures of this life, you will miss the road to heaven. Another thing that tarnishes our image and makes us unfit is lust between men and women. Study the word of God, become its friend, and let it be part and parcel of you. Keep that word in your heart, and I tell you, you will stay afloat. Even if sin and the devil take you into the dungeon, the power of that word will bring you out. The word will tell you what to do and what not to do. It will tell you what to touch and what not to touch. And if by any chance you are mistakenly accused, surrender yourself; God will bring you out, and the word will bring you out. Youths in this church, it is up to you now to make your own decision. We will read Deuteronomy 30:11, 15 and 19 —then I leave you to make your choice. "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:"

I am a product of the nurture of campus fellowship. Saved in early January 1985. Got admission into Rivers State University of Science and Technology, Port Harcourt in 1986 when there was no presence of AVS activity on campus. But in 1987 fate brought me and Bro Mfon Udoh together who was a year ahead of me.

Challenged by this dearth of spiritual activity, and driven by hunger for evangelism and spiritual stability on campus, we started holding fellowship in our room, in the hostels of accommodation. What started as two-man prayer meeting in a closed-door scenario gave birth and growth into campus AVS (now AFCF) in RSU, PH. We reported our intention and activity on campus to the mother

AVS in church, which in turn started to send AVS members and Ministers to fellowship with us on campus weekly.

Our attendance grew in number as we launched out of our room. Souls were converted and saved. This gladdened our hearts and strengthened my faith. Besides, God made us leading students academically in our various departments and faculties. I was the best in my Department and Faculty. Campus AVS soon became popular by reason of our academic excellence and spiritual high standard.

Propelled by love for lost souls, we launched out to other sister tertiary institutions in the State; Uniport and Kenpoly (then Boripoly). Campus AVS became my first evangelism springboard, faith enhancer and bonding factor among the brethren (youths). After my compulsory National Service in 1991, I reunited with the brethren on campus while I pursued my higher degree. Today, I still fellowship with the AFCF often as I work in one of the Universities as an academic staff. I give God all the glory that the activities of campus AVS (now AFCF) are carried out strongly in five campuses of four tertiary institutions in the state, and its impact effectively felt among school communities.
